## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority (PKHA), in order to ensure the successful execution of its large infrastructure contracts, requires that works are awarded only to firms possessing adequate experience in works of similar nature and complexity, particularly in the **Roads Projects**. Such firms must also demonstrate sound financial capacity, competent management capability, and the availability of the required equipment, personnel, and technical resources to execute the works within the stipulated time.

For this purpose, PKHA undertakes an assessment of the capability and capacity of interested firms prior to inviting them to participate in the bidding process for PKHA projects. This assessment is carried out through a **Pre-Qualification process**, whereby contractors are evaluated based on their technical experience, financial strength, managerial competence, and availability of essential resources.

Applicants may be encouraged to form **Joint Ventures (JV)** in order to combine their financial, technical, and managerial resources, thereby ensuring the smooth, efficient, and professional execution of the works.

The present case of pre-qualification relates to the **IMPROVEMENT & REHABILITATION OF ABBOTTABAD – NATHIAGALI – BARRIAN ROAD (57.50 KM). SUBHEAD: PACKAGE-1: IMPROVEMENT / WIDENING & REHABILITATION OF ROAD FROM MURREE CHOWK TO BAGNOTAR**

## 2. Project Description

The Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority (PKHA), hereinafter referred to as the Employer, intends to prequalify qualified and experienced contractors for the execution of the Project **“IMPROVEMENT & REHABILITATION OF ABBOTTABAD – NATHIAGALI – BARRIAN ROAD (57.50 KM). SUBHEAD: PACKAGE-1: IMPROVEMENT / WIDENING & REHABILITATION OF ROAD FROM MURREE CHOWK TO BAGNOTAR”**.

### A. Project Introduction

The Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority (PKHA) is planning to undertake the **“IMPROVEMENT & REHABILITATION OF ABBOTTABAD – NATHIAGALI – BARRIAN ROAD (57.50 KM). SUBHEAD: PACKAGE-1: IMPROVEMENT / WIDENING & REHABILITATION OF ROAD FROM MURREE CHOWK TO BAGNOTAR”**, which together form an important road network within the Galiyat region of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

These corridors constitute strategically important inter-provincial routes, connecting Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with the Province of Punjab through the Galiyat belt. Originating from Abbottabad, the road traverses through the core mountainous tourist region and reaches Barrian, which serves as the inter-provincial junction with Punjab. The route functions as a primary access corridor for several hill stations, scattered hill communities, commercial centers, and tourism facilities located along the alignment.

The project road pass through some of the most prominent tourist destinations in Pakistan, including Nathia Gali, Dungagali, and Ayubia, which attract a large number of domestic and international visitors throughout the year. Consequently, the roads carry a diverse traffic composition, including local traffic, commercial transport, and a substantial seasonal influx of tourist vehicles. This high tourism activity places significant operational and structural demands on the existing road infrastructure.

The region experiences severe climatic conditions, particularly during the winter season. Snowfall generally begins in mid-November and continues until March, during which snow may remain accumulated on the road surface for extended periods. To maintain connectivity, extensive snow clearance operations using heavy machinery are routinely carried out. In addition, repeated freeze–thaw cycles, heavy rainfall, and mountainous terrain conditions accelerate pavement deterioration and significantly increase maintenance requirements compared to normal highway sections.

The roads were recently transferred to the Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority in October 2025. At the time of takeover, the pavement structure and associated road infrastructure were observed to be in poor and deteriorated condition, mainly due to prolonged exposure to harsh weather, aging pavement layers, inadequate drainage systems, and insufficient maintenance over time.

Considering the strategic, economic, and tourism importance of these corridors, the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa has decided to undertake immediate rehabilitation and improvement works in order to restore the structural condition of the pavement, improve geometric and safety standards, and ensure reliable year-round connectivity across the Galiyat region.

Given the strategic importance of the project for tourism, regional mobility, and inter-provincial connectivity, the construction activities will require the mobilization of adequate construction machinery, specialized equipment, skilled manpower, and efficient project

management resources. Contractors will be required to execute the works in a timely, efficient, and professional manner in order to avoid disruptions to tourism activity and local mobility along this vital corridor.

Accordingly, the prequalification process has been initiated to identify and shortlist technically competent and financially sound contractors who possess proven experience in executing similar works, particularly in mountainous terrain and high-tourism corridors, and who are capable of mobilizing the necessary resources to complete the works within the stipulated time frame.

## **B. Scope of Works**

### **Project Overview**

The Project involves “IMPROVEMENT & REHABILITATION OF ABBOTTABAD – NATHIAGALI – BARRIAN ROAD (57.50 KM). SUBHEAD: PACKAGE-1: IMPROVEMENT / WIDENING & REHABILITATION OF ROAD FROM MURREE CHOWK TO BAGNOTAR”, road structures, toll plazas, tourism infrastructure, and ancillary works.

## **2. Construction Stage**

- Upon approval of all design documents, the Contractor shall execute the works, including:

### **Roadworks**

- Excavation, cutting, embankment, subgrade preparation.
- Pavement rehabilitation, resurfacing, and strengthening works.
- Widening and dualization of designated sections.

### **Structures & Drainage**

- Construction/rehabilitation of bridges, culverts, retaining walls, breast walls, gabions, and slope protection and slope stabilization
- Implementation of approved stormwater and snow management drainage systems.

### **Road Safety & Traffic Management**

- Installation of all road safety features (guardrails, crash barriers, signage, road markings, reflectors).
- Traffic management during construction for safe movement of vehicles, tourists, and pedestrians.

### **Tourism & Bazaar Infrastructure**

- Construction of viewpoints, rest areas, tourist amenities, and bazaar beautification.
- Landscaping, parking bays, and ancillary facilities for operational safety and aesthetics.

## Toll Plazas

- Construction of toll plazas, traffic lanes, IT/electronic systems, control buildings, and lighting.

## Construction Facilities & Plant Mobilization

- Mobilization of machinery, equipment, and skilled manpower.
- Installation of asphalt plants, concrete batching plants, crushing plants, and other facilities for timely execution.

## Ancillary Works

- Utility relocation, environmental protection, erosion control, and additional works required for proper completion.
- Permanent supervision by Contractor's expert design teams to ensure compliance with approved designs, PEC standards, FIDIC, and KP regulations.

### **Note:**

*All works described above are mandatory. The Contractor shall also carry out any additional works, designs, or activities required at site for proper completion and functionality, even if not explicitly mentioned, in accordance with approved drawings, specifications, and Client/Supervisory Consultant instructions.*

*The Contractor's expert design teams shall review all designs and shall be available for the full contract duration, ensuring that all road, structure, drainage, tourism, toll, bazaar, and snow management works are designed, supervised, and executed to the highest technical, safety, and operational standards.*

3. It is expected that Invitation to Bid will be issued by 01/04/2026.
4. Pre-qualification is open to constructors/joint ventures of constructors who are registered with PEC in Category C-A with specialization code **CE-01, CE-02, BC-02, EE-06, CE-10 & CE-11**, KPRA and with Pakhtunkhwa Highway Authority (PKHA) in required category and financial limit in accordance with specific contracts to be executed by PKHA. Applications may be submitted for pre-qualification for the above Works.
5. ## 3.0 INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

### 3.1 Submission of Applications

- 3.1.1 Applications are invited for Pre-Qualification of Contractors in Pakhtunkhwa Highway Authority Peshawar for the following work(s). The firm or all partner of a JV must be registered with Pakhtunkhwa Highway Authority and must have valid KPRA & PEC license of required limit (having relevant codes of specialty).

The PKHA reserves the right to accept or reject any application.

- 3.1.2 The applications shall be prepared in the English language. Information in any other language shall be accomplished by its translation in English. Employer reserves the rights for Pre-qualification in case of non-compliance of the above requirement.
- 3.1.3 The Applicants must respond to all questions and provide complete information as advised in this document. Any lapses to provide essential information may result in dis-qualification of the Applicant.

### 3.2 Qualification Criteria

#### 3.2.1 General

Bidders' qualifications will be based on the bidder's eligibility, general and particular experience, personnel and equipment capabilities and financial position, as demonstrated by the bidder's responses in the forms attached. Sub-contractor's experience and resources shall not be taken into account in determining the bidder's compliance with the qualifying criteria. However, Joint Venture experience & resources shall be considered. Consortium or Association of firms will be considered for similar treatment as in the case of Joint Venture.

Maximum Marks are 100. Fail/pass criteria shall be used. Overall passing marks are 70 % and 50% Marks are mandatory to get in each category. Qualification of each bidder will be evaluated considering his technical and financial capabilities to undertake the contract package.

### **Mandatory Requirements / Eligibility:**

- i. An Applicant may be an entity or any combination of entities with an existing agreement in the form of a Joint Venture. In the case of a Joint Venture:
  - a) All partners shall be jointly and severally liable; and
  - b) The Joint Venture shall nominate a Representative who shall have the authority to conduct all business for and on behalf of any and all the partners of the Joint Venture during the prequalification process; in the event the Joint Venture is prequalified, during the bidding process; and, in the event the Joint Venture is awarded the Contract, during contract execution. (*Attach existing JV Agreement*)
- ii. An Applicant, and all partners constituting the Applicant, shall have the nationality of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan. An Applicant shall be deemed to have the nationality of Pakistan if the Applicant is constituted, incorporated and operates in conformity with the provisions of the laws of Pakistan.
- iii. An Applicant shall be duly licensed by the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) in C-A category with specialization codes CE-01, CE-02, BC-02, EE-06, CE-10 & CE-11.

In case of Joint Venture (JV), all partners shall be duly licensed by PEC; however, the Lead Partner shall meet the aforesaid licensing requirement of C-A category with the stated specialization codes.

In case the validity of the license has expired, the Applicant must have applied for renewal prior to submission of its application.

(Attach copy of valid PEC License. In case validity has expired, application for renewal along with fee receipt shall also be submitted)
- iv. An Applicant shall be registered/enlisted with C&W Department Khyber Pakhtunkhwa in the required category.
- v. An Applicant shall be registered with the Income Tax Department and must be on the Active Taxpayer List (ATL) of the Federal Board of Revenue at the time of submission of its Application. Moreover, the Applicant shall have valid registration with KPRA. (*Attach copy of Income Tax/FBR registration, Extract of ATL and tax returns for the last three years*)
- vi. An Applicant shall not have been blacklisted or debarred by any Government or semi-Government Organization/Department or by any foreign country, international organization or foreign institution. (*The Applicant shall submit an undertaking on Rs.100 Stamp Paper duly attested by Notary Public.*)
- vii. **Conflict of Interest**

Applicants shall not have a conflict of interest. All Applicants found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. Applicants may be considered to have a conflict of interest if:

  - a. An Applicant participates in more than one Application in this prequalification process, either individually or as a partner in a Joint Venture. This will result in disqualification of all such Applications;

- b. Two or more Applicants are partially or wholly owned or controlled by common individuals, regardless of their shareholding; however, such Applicants may form one Joint Venture to participate as a single Applicant; or
- c. An Applicant or its affiliated entity participated as a consultant in preparation of the design or technical specifications of the works subject to this Prequalification.
- viii. Any Applicant not fulfilling the above mandatory requirements/eligibility criteria shall be rejected outright, and no further evaluation shall be carried out.
- ix. Applicants shall provide such evidence of their continued eligibility as the Employer may reasonably request.
- x. The materials, equipment and services to be supplied under the Contract shall originate from countries with which Pakistan maintains commercial/trade relations, in accordance with the applicable laws of Pakistan.

**Qualification Requirements:**

Pre-qualification will be based on the criteria given in succeeding paras 3.2.2 to 3.2.6 regarding the Applicant’s Financial Soundness, Experience Record, Personnel Capabilities and Equipment Capabilities as demonstrated by the Applicant’s responses in the forms attached to this letter. The Employer reserves the right to waive minor deviations, if these don’t materially affect the capability of an applicant to perform the contract. Sub-contractor’s experience and resources shall not be taken into account in determining the Applicant’s compliance with the qualifying criteria. However, Joint Venture experience & resources shall be considered. Consortium or Association of firms will be considered for similar treatment as in case of Joint Venture.
